### **Sergeant Jeffry T. Edelson Scholarship Fund Eligibility**

4 students will be eligible to receive a one-time scholarship in the amount of \$2,500.00 and 18 students will be eligible to receive a one-time scholarship in the amount of \$2,000.00 in 2023.

### **Guidelines for Scholarship Eligibility**

The Sergeant Jeffry T. Edelson Scholarship is open to children/stepchildren of all NYS Troopers (active, retired, and BCI associate members) in good standing.

- Students must supply proof of acceptance or attendance with the submission of their application
- The scholarship may be used for tuition, room, board and/or books
- Must be accepted as a full-time student (12 credit hours per semester) at an accredited college for the upcoming semester
- May be enrolled in an associate degree program at a two year community college, an undergraduate program at a four year college, or a graduate degree program
- Must maintain a 2.5 or greater grade point average
